**Madison Symphony Orchestra announces Auditions for 2016-17 season**

The Madison Symphony Orchestra will hold auditions for the 2016-17 season on the following schedule:

<b>Tues.-Wed., Sept. 6-7</b>	<b>Section Violin</b> (three Regular positions, 1 Violin I; 2 Violin II; one 1-year position, possibly permanent, Violin I)
<b>Thurs., Sept. 8</b>	<b>Section Viola</b> (one Regular position)
<b>Fri., Sept. 9</b>	<b>Principal and Section Bass</b> (two Regular positions)
<b>Sat., Sept. 10</b>	<b>Substitute Cello; Substitute Bassoon</b>

If a current member of the MSO wins a new position, these auditions may be used to fill the resulting opening.

Qualified candidates are encouraged to sign up for an audition time by emailing a one-page resume to [acarreon@madisonsymphony.org](mailto:acarreon@madisonsymphony.org). A list of excerpts and a season schedule are also available. A \$50 refundable deposit will be required to secure an audition time.

All musicians qualifying for a position will be expected to attend all rehearsals and concerts as instrumentation demands. The MSO is a professional, fully orchestrated ensemble comprised of 91 contracted per-service musicians, offering approximately 80 services per season.
